# Chiropractic Survey (1 credit) Biology 498 (Selected Topics in Biology)

#### <u>Syllabus</u>

## Course Prerequisites

- 1. Pre-chiropractic emphasis (or other pre-professional health science).
- 2. Completion of 30 credit hours toward chiropractic requirements, including Biology 160 and Chemistry 105 or 115.
- 3. Pre-approval of faculty advisor in special circumstances.

### Grading

Pass/Fail Grading evaluated by on-campus and shadowing experience advisor.

#### Course Credit Requirements

- 1. Office Shadow. Participation with selected doctors of chiropractic on their daily rounds, involving consultation, physical, orthopedic, and neurological exams, X-ray evaluation, patient treatment and case management. May include review of office procedures and practice protocol. You must find and arrange for this element on your own. Actual shadowing time must be a minimum of 12 contact hours (documented). A brief 1-2 page summary of your shadowing experience is required.
- 2. Paper on Selected Topics in Chiropractic. Write a short review paper (3-4 pages). Topic should be on some aspect of current clinical/research studies in health care that involve or affect Chiropractic. Have your topic approved by Dr. Bell first.
- 3. Chiropractic Club meeting attendance. Attend any Chiropractic Club meetings held during the semester. Meetings might include presentations by area practitioners, student presentations on areas of interest, trips to chiropractic colleges, presentations by recruiters from chiropractic colleges.
