**COURSE REQUIREMENTS:**

1. **Attendance and participation:** Your regular attendance and active participation in Spanish 102 are extremely important for success in this course. If you have more than **four absences**--with or without an excuse, your final grade will be lowered by one point for each absence exceeding four. If you are not in class, it is your responsibility to turn in all homework prior to the absence and to obtain the assignments from a classmate. In order to receive complete credit you need to participate fully and voluntarily in class discussion, be respectful to others, arrive on time—not leave early, and not use your cell phone. The ringing or checking of cell phones during class will affect your participation grade. If you look at email, text messages, or take photos during an exam or quiz, you will receive a zero for that exam or quiz.

2. **Preparation and homework:** It is necessary to study beforehand the lesson assigned and to have completed the homework for that day. **LATE HOMEWORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** You should study two hours outside of class for every hour in class. This means that you should study a minimum of **eight hours** per week. Your homework will include:

a. The student will do the daily homework assigned.

b. The student will complete the corresponding activities for each chapter in the ***Student Activities Manual***. The *manual* will be finished by the day of the corresponding chapter quiz.

3. There will be **six quizzes**, one for each chapter. If you are not in class on the day of a quiz, you will receive a 0. No make-up quizzes are allowed. The lowest quiz grade will be eliminated at the end of the semester. Your final grade for this component will be the average of the remaining five quizzes.
