A Christmas Carol - The Musical Director's Note

Marley was dead, to begin with.

I was hooked. Was there ever a more intriguing opening line to a story?

Apparently, I'm not the only fan of Charles Dickens novels. Of the 25 novels and novellas that he wrote, 15 or so have never been out of print since their publication. His novella *A Christmas Carol*, published in 1843, is probably his most widely known and adapted. A year after publication, there were eight theatrical productions running in London concurrently. There have been 32 film and animation adaptations, 34 television adaptations and 64 stage adaptations, including the version we are presenting to you this evening.

A Christmas Carol – The Musical was originally produced for the month of December from 1994 through 2003 at the Theatre at Madison Square Garden. With music by Alan Menken, who was just becoming known for his work on Disney films (*The Little Mermaid*, *Beauty and the Beast*, *Newsies*, *Aladdin*, *Pocohantas*, *The Hunchback of Notre Dame*, *Hercules*, *Enchanted* and *Tangled*) and lyrics by Lynn Ahrens (*Once On This Island*, *Ragtime*, *Seussical* and *Anastasia*) one couldn't ask for a more tuneful and catchy score.

We have a cast of 26 student actors, covering over 100 different roles, as well as 14 voice off-stage ensemble providing glorious vocal support and understudying various roles. Of course, it wouldn't be *A Christmas Carol* without a Tiny Tim and we are so fortunate to have 9 young actors from the Stevens Point community joining the cast in various children's roles. It has been a wonderful experience for all of us to work together with these talented young people and their supportive families on this production.

As always, I have been supported tremendously by my colleagues and student designers, technicians and stage managers who have all brought such beautiful work to the production.

Welcome to the world of Ebenezer Scrooge and his Ghostly companions as you witness one man's redemption while he learns the true meaning of the holiday season.
