Parking Rules & Regulations

We want to ensure safe, adequate and orderly parking for our students, faculty, staff, and visitors.

Preferred Parking Permits

for the easiest access to campus buildings

⇒ Students, members of the public, and staff may purchase permits for

Lots E and G: \$40 for one semester or \$75 for the year.

- ⇒ All other lots on campus require permits that are limited by class (Lot B for staff)
- \Rightarrow Permits are required 7am to 5 pm Monday-Friday, September 1 - June 1.
- \Rightarrow No overnight parking.
- ⇒ A permit for Lots E or G does not guarantee a spot but parking is usually plentiful.

Purchasing Permits

⇒ Permits may be purchased with cash or check in the Business Center (room 166) during regular business hours.



Free Parking

Parking is available on nearby city streets and in Marathon Park. Please note that parking on city streets is under jurisdiction of the City of Wausau Police Department. Parking in Marathon Park is under the jurisdiction of the Marathon County Parks Department.

Visitor Parking

Visitor parking is available in the following locations:

- \Rightarrow Lot C: 30-minute parking, accessible from 7th Ave.
- ⇒ Lot G: Designated visitor spaces on the North side of Lot G; limited to one hour
- \Rightarrow 15-minute street parking on 7th Ave.

Community Event Parking

The campus reserves the right to alter parking regulations for special events. Parking permits may be deemed unnecessary for large community events.



Violations and Fines

Violations stated below will be subject to fines as indicated:

- \$10 Improper/Failure to Display: Improper or failure display of permit
- \$15 <u>Limited Zone:</u> Parking in "limited" zone
- \$25 <u>No Parking Area:</u> Parking in "No Parking" area, reserved stall, in a driving lane, over yellow lines
- \$25 No Valid Permit for Lot: Parking in an unassigned lot, no valid campus permit, including to park overnight
- \$50 **No Valid Handicap Permit Displayed**: Parking in an area reserved for individuals with disabilities
- \$50 **Fire Zone**: Parking in fire zone
- \$100 Misuse of or selling permit
