## Build a foundation for success with an Associate of Arts and Sciences (AAS) Degree

The AAS degree puts you on the path to a bachelor's degree and is transferable to institutions across the UW System. It provides you with a liberal arts general education and a breadth of intellectual and practical skills.

### General Degree Requirements

1. You must complete a minimum of 60 credits to receive the AAS. At least 15 of the 60 credits must be earned at the institution's three campuses.
2. You must have a grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 earned cumulatively at the institution's three campuses, and a 2.0 overall GPA in credits applied to the AAS.
3. The AAS general education requirements must be fulfilled.

## Apply

Apply for admission through the UW System Application as soon as possible after August 1. [uwsp.edu/apply](http://uwsp.edu/apply)

Applicants should submit:

- High school transcripts\*
- ACT or SAT scores (optional and self-reported)\*\*

\*Unofficial high school transcripts will be accepted for admission consideration.

Cumulative grade point averages can be self-reported.

\*\*ACT and SAT scores are optional and self-reported for admissions consideration, but may be required for scholarship consideration.

## Scholarships

Complete the scholarship application. Priority consideration will be given to students who have been admitted and submitted their scholarship application by December 15 and March 1 at [uwsp.edu/wausau/admissions/Pages/scholarships.aspx](http://uwsp.edu/wausau/admissions/Pages/scholarships.aspx).
