Colleagues,

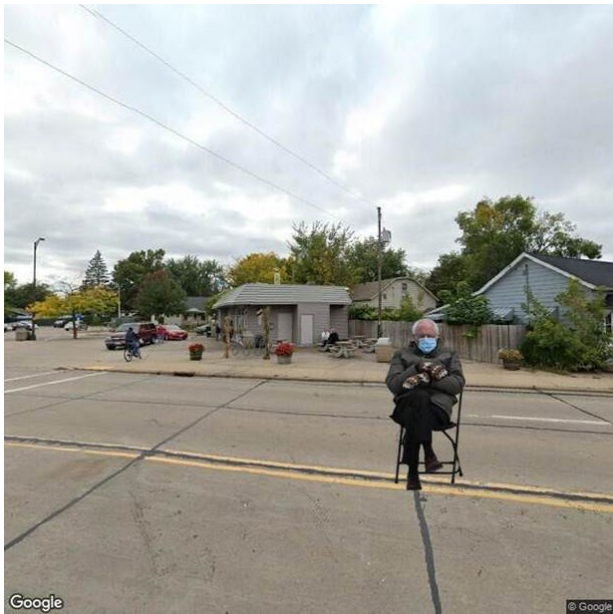
Welcome back to the Spring 2021 semester!

I understand there are still many questions regarding how specifically we should be meeting these expectations. However, for now, please know that the spirit of this requirement is to expand our surveillance testing beyond residential students to include any student or employee who is regularly on campus. The intent is not to screen people prior to their coming to campus, but rather simply to help slow the spread of the virus through routine proactive testing. Generally, if employees are on campus at least once per week, they should participate in this program and get tested once every two weeks. I urge you to take advantage of this opportunity to help protect the health of our campuses and the broader community.

We all know that 2020 was a strange and difficult year, and thus far, 2021 has had its share of crazy. But the days are growing longer, vaccines are on the way, and speaking personally, it feels good to work for an institution whose purpose is to foster the pursuit of truth through critical thinking, a skill the world appears sorely to need.
