### Schmeckle Reserve Ecological Restoration Crew Member

The primary mission of Schmeckle Reserve is to protect, manage, and restore native ecological communities of central Wisconsin. This position is part of a seasonal crew that assists with numerous ecological restoration projects in the campus natural area.

#### Specific Duties:

- Assist with identification and mapping of exotic invasive species populations.
- Manual removal of invasive plants and shrubs.
- Chemical treatment of invasive plants and shrubs.
- Planting of native vegetation in areas of invasive species removal.
- Educate Schmeckle visitors about ecological restoration.
- Other duties as assigned by the Ecological Restoration Crew Leader.

#### Requirements:

- Full-time UW-Stevens Point student

- Willing to work outdoors in all conditions
- Able to walk long distances during shift, and lift and carry shrubs/branches with up to 3"-diameter trunks

#### Preferred Experience:

- Previous experience with invasive species removal and other restoration techniques is helpful, but will train

#### Commitment:

- May to December with some weekend work
- Hours vary based on schedule: 6-10 hrs/week during semesters, and up to 40 hrs/week in summer
