Goal Area: VI

Objective: VI.1 & 2: Establish a research working group and identify completed EE research in Wisconsin (1997-2007) to help ensure future EE endeavors will be “based on research findings.”

Activities, Measurable Outcomes, Person(s) responsible and Timelines:

June 30: Review and accept research abstracting form (Dan)

August 31: Conduct pilot of EE research literature review (All)

Each committee member will identify and assess sources of EE research (databases, search engines, libraries, etc.) and each committee members complete at least 3 abstracts from various sources

September: Develop and initiate plan for EE literature review (All)

Based on pilot, the committee will determine best approach for completing the EE literature review (e.g., graduate students from one or more institutions of higher education).

Outcomes: Abstracting form, identification of EE research sources, and 12 completed abstracts.

Resource needed: Mainly time. There will be a meeting (most likely a conference call) in September. If we end up involving students in the literature review, the respective universities will be asked to help support their work—we will know more in September after the pilot.
