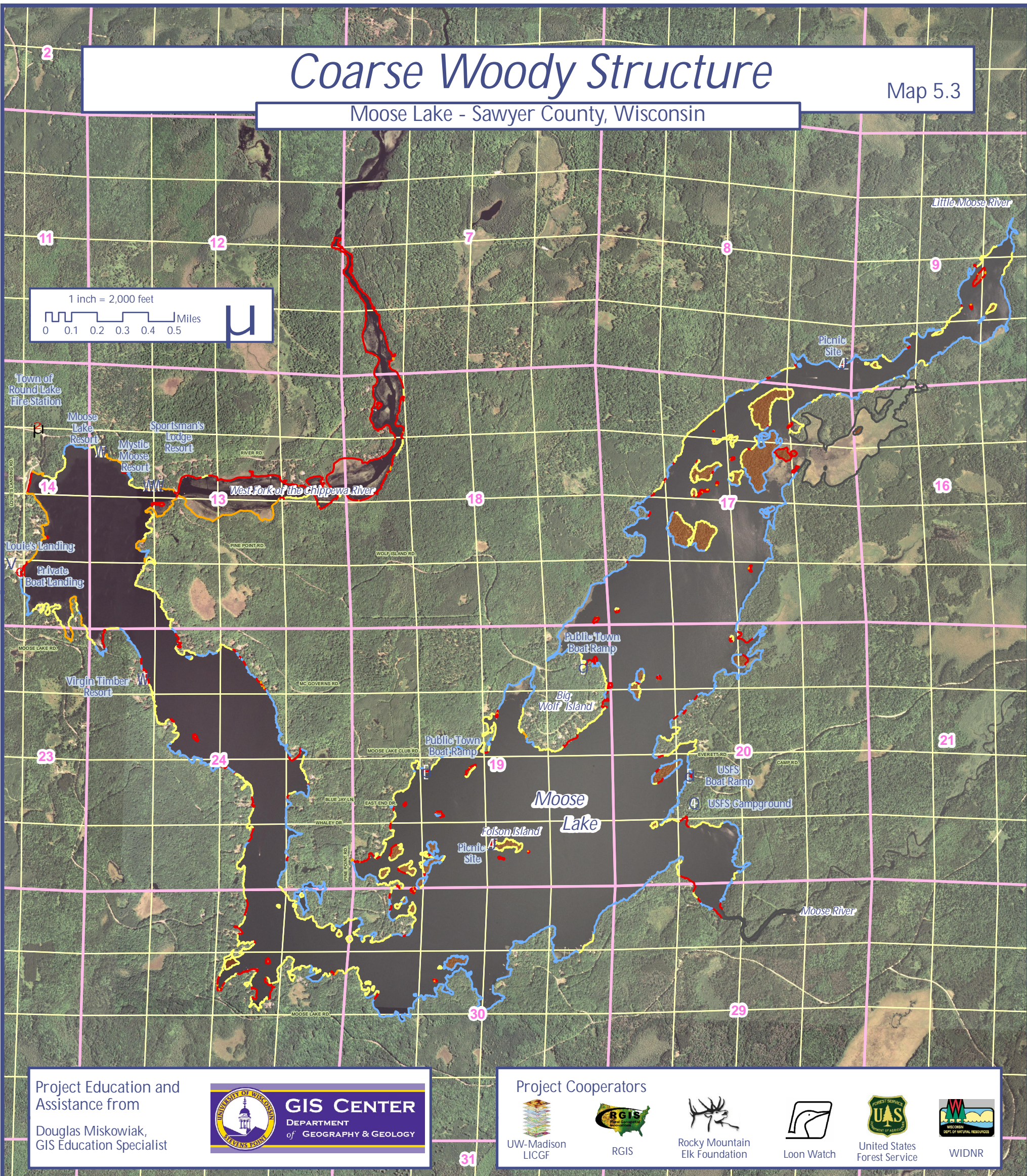


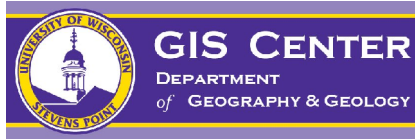

Coarse Woody Structure

- Continuous ————— 18.32 miles or 37% of all shoreline
- Scattered ————— 16.15 miles or 32%
- Isolated ————— 2.30 miles or 5%
- Absent ————— 9.52 miles or 19%
- Area Unobserved ————— 3.65 or 7 %

DATA SOURCES

Coarse woody structure field inventoried by citizens of Moose Lake in Sawyer County, Wisconsin, 2008. The inventory was conducted in the littoral zone of Moose Lake. Attributes, indicating the density of woody structure along the shoreline, were affixed to the Moose Lake shoreline denoted on large format hardcopy maps. Hardcopy maps were scanned with a large format Context scanner, georeferenced to the Sawyer County Coordinate System and digitized to the Moose Lake shoreline geodatabase. Douglas Miskowiak, from UW-Stevens Point scanned, georeferenced, and digitized coarse woody structure.
