I remember several of those sermons about people who just do their daily job doing it well, and they are the real heroes. Since being in the service I have seen a lot of fellows, not conspirators, yet something about them showed that they are really different. I admire them and altho they do not ~~seem~~ receive any recognition for ~~doing~~ these deeds, yet I know they have a deep personal satisfaction.
