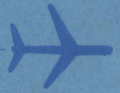


Sunday AM

Dear Family -

8 hours in the air - from Hawaii to Guam -
45 minutes on the ground there - now back in the air
and we should be in Manila in a little over an hour.

The plane left Hawaii at 1:30 AM (Sunday) Hawaii time -
yet it was still dark (8 hours later) when we landed
at Guam - such is the way with jet travel. They
served scrambled eggs, ham and fruit for breakfast and
I managed to sleep some although the "economy" seats
are not big enough for my long legs! It is amazing to
we now full the plane - not an empty seat to
Guam and we filled the seats that were vacated at
Guam by deplaning and enplaning passengers.

Lana and Larry Sato took me to the airport - I spent
the evening with them. Their church, St. Andrew's Episcopal
was having a festival and Lana was working in the
booth that sold a Chinese food (noodles, peas, onions, sp
and a pork broth similar to chicken with). Larry picked
me up at the hotel at 6 PM and we went to the church -

be there and then went to Sato's home while they
put their youngsters - three cute girls, Sharon, Geri, Mimi,
and then Lana's mother stayed with the girls while we
went over to friends of the Sato's and watched the Hawaii
primary election returns on TV. The host is a
candidate for the Hawaiian legislature and I was not
intending to be in their home (of Japanese ancestry)
and enjoy their hospitality. We took our shoes off and
left them on the front porch (it rained while we were in
the house and my shoes were damaged when I put them on!).
We stayed there until 11:30 and then left for the airport.
Lana impressed with the way they involve their youngsters in
all activities - the small children of some of the guests stayed
in the living room, ate and then went to sleep on
the floor while the rest of us were watching TV.

My short stay in Hawaii was too full and yet not memorable.
We must go and visit when we have some time - it is
a fascinating state and so much to see and do. The Satos
went out of their way to be good hosts and they were wonderful
now Lana filled with an farewell - for the weeks ahead -
indeed for the next hour and who will meet me and
where I will go - I have all of you in my mind - heart -
