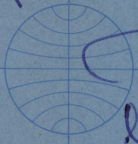

IN FLIGHT AIR LETTER



I mailed a note to you yesterday afternoon - but
last night I was too tired to write.

Our plane arrived at 1400 - two hours late -
Harry was there to meet me and after bringing my luggage
to the room I went over to the office + saw everyone -
gave messages, etc and worked on some of my paper
work until supper.

I took a shower and fell into bed at 9 pm -
sleeping through until 0800 this morning. A rough week
nights and I'll be back on schedule!

Today has been full. We left at 0730 for a flight
to Dalat - visited and toured the University of Dalat -
the Atomic Energy Institute and the Military Academy.
All institutions were most interesting to see - different and
not easy to describe. Dalat is 5000 feet above sea
level and is very much like the mountains of eastern
Colorado except in addition to ~~pine~~ pine trees there are
bananas, palms and strawberries. It is a fine setting
for a University however and they have a lovely
location and quite interesting program. The most interesting
building is the chapel.

The wind was quite strong + we had to fly out
in two groups - ferrying 1/2 of our team to an airstrip
at lower altitude and then going back for rest - we
all made it back here OK though and it is good to
be here - relaxed + talking with you. My love to each
