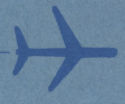

My Dear Family -

The end of a full day - and a full week. Most time was spent in the office this morning - and this afternoon I interviewed a Dr. Jacobs who is USAID representative to a new South East Asia Ministers of Education organization. We talked about the new organization and its objectives, plans and programs.

Somehow both of our diners got away for several hours this afternoon - so Harry and I ended up walking about 3 miles from our interview with Dr. Jacobs.

This evening I treated members of the group to dinner - we are at the Majestic Hotel - over looking the Saigon River - and while we ate watched the full moon rise in the East - just a month ago we were in Hue and watched the moon come up there. One more full moon, and I'll be home for the one after that.

Tonight my eyelids are heavy and lashed. It was good to get your letter, written in 3 instalments - the 1st, 19th & 20th, in the mail today. Goodnight to each one - my love to you and you all in my heart tonight.
