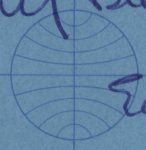


Saigon, Vietnam

Today the team is visiting the faculty of Architecture and this afternoon we tour some pharmaceutical laboratories. The Delta is sponsoring a cocktail party this afternoon and tonight we are guests of the Sec of Housing at his home for dinner.

Very shortly I'll leave for a meeting with La Follette & others - another meeting on her train. I'll be glad when this is finally settled.

We have presented money & cigarettes to our driver (for Tet) and will give gifts to those at hotel. The manager will get cigarettes & light food - the Bell Bar the same and I have picked up soap, Tang, etc for my cleaning & laundry women.

This weekend I hope to make a loop to go back to the campus trying to explain Tet and some of the customs associated with it. Very interesting.
