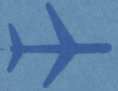

My Dear Family -

Two letters today - one from Phil - which I will answer tomorrow - and another from Mother.

Today was spent at the Rebarade - in preparation for our trip to Dalat on Monday - I did a series of errands - to APO - to USOM - and to the APO - the afternoon was taken up largely with a meeting of the team - at which time we discussed some of our organizational matters out and also took care of some house keeping chores.

This evening we ate "on the local market" - I had some french onion soup that was excellent - lots of cheese + bread & the onions were very fine.

Mel got back ok - said the helicopter had to hedge hog to buy low enough so he could not short it - he had quite an experience and was pleased for it.

I am tired tonight - it has been a long week and I am glad the 2nd full week is past. In a sense the time passes quickly - in another the time not fast enough.

My love for you is very real and very strong and I miss you very much.
