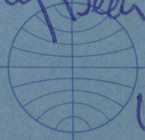


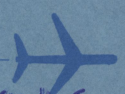

AN FLIGHT AIR LETTER



Well, we made it. That is our preliminary report draft is completed as far as our work is concerned. We have hit a bottle neck - that is the wineograph section of AID - they haven't gotten anything back to us for 3 days - so we may be mostly assembling materials on Monday and Tuesday - but the text is completed. I feel let down tonight and am really looking forward to the weekend.

Very shortly I'll leave for dinner - with one of the faculty members in the Faculty of letters. We met him at the dinner last Sunday night and he seems to be very interesting - a PhD from Cal Tech and in Aeronautical Engineering - although he is teaching applied math here at the University of Saigon.

I did want to get this written now because I don't know how late it will be when I get in - although I plan to make it easy.
