## Students' Responsibilities

Students are responsible for

- o being prepared to discuss personal values and goals as they relate to academic and career-related needs;
- o determining a course of study that satisfies the requirements defined for the appropriate degree in the UWSP catalog;
- o being knowledgeable about policies, procedures, and requirements as published;
- o preparing for an advising session by having the necessary forms available and a list of questions and courses (and alternatives) needed;
- o scheduling and appearing promptly for appointments with the adviser when necessary (at least once each semester);
- o following through with appropriate action after the advising meeting; and
- o accepting responsibility for the academic decisions to be made.

## Faculty/Academic Staff Responsibilities

Faculty and academic staff who serve as advisers are responsible for

- o being responsive to discussions of students' personal values and goals as they relate to academic and career-related needs;
- o assisting the student in identifying and pursuing educational goals and objectives and in securing information about career opportunities;
- o helping the student examine course offerings in the major:
- o relate these to courses in the student's broader field of study;
- o understand the graduation requirements for the chosen curriculum.
