COURSE TITLE: Senior Exhibition

CREDIT HOURS:

Mondays Wednesdays 14:00 -16:15

CATALOG DESCRIPTION: Senior Exhibition. 4 cr. Prepare senior portfolio (graphic design emphasis) or gallery show (2-D or 3-D emphasis). Studio work to enhance and complete student portfolio: organize and install an exhibition in the Edna Carlsten Gallery or participate in the Graphic Design Senior Portfolio Review; faculty evaluation of exhibition.

COURSE OBJECTIVE: This is the second part of a two-course capstone sequence

(490-491). The objective is to prepare you for your senior exhibition this Spring by using critical analysis and specialized feedback of your artwork. We will also complete additional materials relevant to: exhibiting work and self-promotion as a working artist.

COURSE CONTENT: This is a capstone experience for students attempting to complete the requirements for the BFA degree in Art. This course is designed to provide the senior studio student with: a) reserved time and space to assemble a fully developed body of work for exhibition

> b) an understanding of the professional practices associated with being an active artist.

These practices will include the writing of an artist premise, submittal of a OSCAR Grant*, preparing a vita, completion of a business card, brochure and catalog of your work for the exhibition. We will also look at related activities such as residencies, websites, the business of art and external grants.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS: You are expected to produce a competent, coherent body of work that reflects a commitment to creative

achievement. The work will be extensive in scope to fulfill the requirements of a solo show in a space comparable to the Schneider Student Gallery. This body of work will be evaluated by your faculty committee and edited by you in conjunction with your committee. The Carlsten Gallery Director has final approval of all final aspects of the exhibition. This includes works exhibited, design, lighting, labels etc. The director will work with you and your committee to create a show that best showcases your individual work as well as the group. There will be writing. All first drafts and outlines submitted to me will be hand written in legible form. Only final drafts will be type written.

GRADING POLICIES: Your final grade will be calculated according to the following breakdown:

50% Grade given to you by your committee. This includes content, craft and presentation of your work.

35% Class participation including oral critiques, reading assignments and overall class performance. This includes strict adherence to assigned deadlines.

15% Group exhibition design, promotional materials and installation. Assigned by Gallery Director

OURSCE POLICIES:

UWSP Attendance policy will be enforced: three unexcused absences will reduce your grade by **one full letter grade.** All work is to be turned in on time. There will be no extensions. Failure to meet any of the critical deadlines will be recorded as an F for that session.

Incompletes will not be given either as a project or semester grade.

Evaluations are based on completion and the quality of the work as submitted at the specified deadline.
