Course Description and Objective: This class teaches quantitative management science techniques to solve business problems such as facility layout, process planning, work measurement, inventory control, quality control, and includes techniques such as linear programming and statistical process control. (See description in the UWSP Catalog,) The objective of this course is to study the methods used by operations and production managers to make decisions in a company's pursuit of its strategic goals and objectives. Mathematical and spreadsheet tools will be reviewed and or developed as needed.
