Director's Notes

Charles Mee on his writing:

I like plays that are not too neat, too finished, too presentable. My own plays are broken, jagged, filled with sharp edges, filled with things that take sudden turns, careen into each other, smash up, veer off in sickening turns. That feels good to me. It feels like my life. And then I like to put this chaotic stuff – with some sense of struggle remaining – into a classical form, a Greek form, or a beautiful dance theatre piece, or some other effort at civilization.

Recently I have come again and again to take the text of a classic Greek play, smash it to ruins, and then, atop its ruined structure of plot and character, write a new play, with all-new language, characters of today speaking like people of today, set in the America of my time – so that America today lies, as it were, in a bed of ancient ruins.

Big Love is based on one of the earliest extant Greek dramas, The Suppliant Women. It is a LONG way from that text, and only allusions are made to it. Mee's play is a very modern and theatrical re-telling of that early play by Aeschylus. Mee uses the ancient text as a jumping off place to explore sexual politics, strength, weakness, and love.

Mee writes plays that many people have come to call "collage theatre." He is interested in the text that he has written, but he is equally interested in investigating other media to communicate an idea or feeling within the character (and subsequently, the audience). Dance, song, chant, dialogue, theatrical movement all come together and collide on stage often in direct conflict with what we have come to know as "naturalism." These styles compete with each other for your visual and aural focus. Sometimes one overpowers the other; sometimes movement is more important than the voice; and sometimes the voice of the character is paramount. This is a theatrical play, housed in theatrical ways. I hope you embrace (and have fun) with the challenges the production provides an audience.

Mee wants you to explore your own feelings about his play in a visceral way. Within his language, you may be provoked, or perhaps even momentarily offended – but I think this is a passageway to discover what is at the heart of the play. And what is at the heart of the play is . . . well, I guess, Mee would hope it's a little something different for each of you. Big Love is a collage of theatrical forms, styles, and conventions.

I hope you embrace the journey.

Costume Designer's Notes

My primary goal when approaching the costume design for Big Love, as it has been for many of the other shows I've been able to design at UWSP; was to create real, genuine people. Someone you could meet walking down a street. Someone who can exist outside of the realm of the play.

Additionally, the idea of natural beauty and how one achieves what they identify as beauty has been very important for this show. One thing that I have worked on, with the women in particular, is what is it that makes them feel the most beautiful? How they wear their hair, makeup, and what clothes they wear when they are going out and want to look their best? I feel that the looks you will see tonight on the brides are ones that include ideas that have come from them, not only my ideas of how they should look projected onto them. I worked closely with Tyler to create looks for all of the cast members to help them own their body, and feel comfortable in their own skin while they portray their particular character

One of the things that Tyler said during our first design meeting that resonated with me was "Amid the battle of the sexes, we can choose love." This quote has inspired me throughout the design process of this show, and has helped me to assist in creating the production that you are seeing tonight.
