Director's Notes

Welcome to Danstage 2013. For the first time Danstage is being presented in the round with the audience seated on four sides. Distinct from choreographing movement for a proscenium stage with the audience seated facing one direction, this stage configuration has offered the choreographers and designers fresh and expanded ways of approaching our work.

Tonight you will see four premieres.

Guest choreographer Melinda Jean Myers' "head and tail" was created using a "chance" method of choreography in which the dancers flip coins to determine, in real time, the order of movement sequences, movement choices they make in relationship to other dancers, and how these choreographic elements are arranged in space. The performers are challenged to respond to each other quickly while remaining focused on the directions of the game. Thank you to Pamela Luedtke for her fine and important rehearsal direction of this work.

"Hokkaido Sanctuary, Japan 7:21 am", choreographed by Michael Estanich, features fifteen UWSP dancers enacting the emergence of life and cacophony of changing light and sound patterns in the early morning hours. The work is inspired by Taiwanese photographer Feng Ying Ke's images of the red crowned crane taken at the Akan Sanctuary in Hokkaido, Japan. The red crowned crane is seen as a symbol of fidelity, good luck, love, and long life in the Orient.

"Listening In", choreographed by Jeannie Hill, explores what it means to truly listen. During the rehearsal process the cast researched Deaf culture, asking what it's like to converse without our sense of hearing, and what it's like to listen with the senses of the entire self, not only our ears. Communicating through gesture, body percussion and sign language, this tap journey unveils universal feelings about being understood.

My new work "Tacit" was inspired by experiencing the majesty of nature and our deep connection and responsibility to it during my fall 2012 sabbatical residency at The Banff Centre in Alberta, Canada. This is our tacit agreement. Dmitri Shostakovich's stirring Piano Concerto drew me further into the magnificence and beauty available in the world.

Thank you to our wonderful Department of Theatre & Dance technical and design team, stage managers and production crew for their dedication and generosity. Additional thanks to everyone who supports the dancers behind the scenes.

We hope you enjoy the expressive range of our Danstage 2013 performers as we celebrate their deepening artistry.

Choreographer's Note

Guest choreographer Melinda Jean Myers' new work "head and tail", was created in collaboration with the eight cast members during her September 2012 residency at UWSP. The cast members are well acquainted with the very specific choreographic framework, which is structured so that they never perform the sequences the same way twice. The performers have the responsibility to lead, follow, and go along for the ride determined by the flip of a coin, and by choices they make relating to each other, the space, and the form of the dance. In essence, the performers must be fully present and able to respond quickly to each other while remaining focused on the directions of the choreographic game.

Melinda Jean Myers grew up in Stevens Point, Wisconsin where she trained in dance from a young age at her mother's dance studio. She received her BFA from New York University in 2005 and MFA from the University of Iowa in 2012. Melinda was a member of Trisha Brown Dance Company from 2006-2010 and performed throughout Europe, South America and the U.S. She has restaged Trisha Brown's repertory at BARD College and University of Iowa.
