A Note from the Director

BABY opened on Broadway at the Ethel Barrymore theatre in 1983 and was nominated for seven Tony Awards. Its luscious, tuneful and diverse musical score by David Shire, and poignant, touching and ingenious lyrics by Richard Maltby helped make this musical a theatre-cult favorite.

However, it was the universally appealing and undeniably recognizable theme of having a baby that spoke to its audience. In Sybil Pearsen's book, the three central couples facing change from the onset of a baby are forced to look at their own relationships, and in the process, ultimately find a greater humanity within.

It was that humanity that spoke to me when I performed Alan in one of the first regional productions of BABY in 1985. However, when given the opportunity to direct this production, I wondered whether its message would speak so viscerally in 2008. After rereading the script I was extremely moved by its sentiment, but wondered if it still needed to be set in the 1980's. There were so many references to the time period that it occurred to me that perhaps this jewel might be better displayed if it were slightly "dusted off". Therefore, the show you will witness tonight, set on a college campus, uses the students of UWSP to help contemporize the show. These elements are reflected in the wardrobe, color palette, design, references and the ensemble scenes that were developed improvisationally. I wish to thank all the individuals who have contributed greatly in lending their artistic voices to this telling.

Finally, in revisiting this script, I was struck by how eloquently the youngest character, Lizzie, discovers one of life's many mysteries:

....And all these things I feel and more, My mother's mother felt in hers before, A chain of life begun upon the shore Of some dark sea has reached to me. And now I can see the chain extending. My child is next in a line that has no ending. And here am I, full of life, That her child will feel when I'm long gone. And thus it is, The Story Goes on, and on.......
